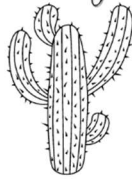

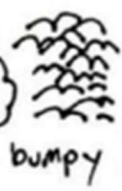

The final result should be a creatively organized composition that displays a wide variety of textures and techniques used to create texture.
